• When install the unit, prevent metal objects falling into the master unit from the vents to avoid short circuit and damaging the device.








## REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION




- 1. TURN ON/OFF key--Turn ON/OFF the screen.
- 2.EJECT Key
  Press to eject the Discs in
  the unit. And press again to
  insert the Disc if you do not
  take out it.
- 3.OPEN key
- 4.MUTE key Press to mute the unit and press again to restore the volume.
- 5.Play/Pause.
- 6.Direction and ENTER key
  If there is a Disc with root list
  menu,press direction key to
  move up/down, and press
  enter to confirm. Press left
  to enter into file list. Right to
  open the file.
- 7.MENU key
  Press menu key to turn back
  to the main interface of the
  unit under any mode.
- 8.Under Disc/SD/USB/video mode, press to choose previous/next song. Under music list menu, press to choose PRE/NEXT page. Under RADIO mode, press to search frequency forward /backward.
- 9. Take phone calls and hang up phone calls.
- 10.Number key Choose music by number key under DISC/Radio mode.

- 11.MODE changing key
  Press to change mode of the
  unit between BT/AUX IN/AV
  IN/Radio/MobileLink/DVD/SD/USB.
- 12.VOLUME UP/DOWN key
  Press to volume up and volume
  down under any mode.
- 13.DVD playing mode, press to go into root list menu; VCD playing mode, press to turn on/off PBC function.
- 14.BAND: Radio mode, touch to change between FM1/FM2/FM3 /AM1/AM2; press STOP and the screen will show LOGO interface; Delete function in BT calling mode.
- 15.FAST REVERSE/FAST FORWARD key Under Disc playing mode, press to fast play reverse/forward at the speed of \*2\*4\*8\*16; under Radio mode, press to search step by step reverse/forward.
- 16.REPEAT key
  Under DISC/Music/Video mode,
  press to set the repeat mode: single,
  chapter,all.
- 17.Under video playing mode, press to check the video playing information such as: playing time, name of the song, total song etc..
- 18. Under DVD playing mode, press to enter into title list menu.
- 19.EQ mode
  Touch to set EQ mode. Touch
  again to adjust EQ effectffect
- 20. Channel changing key: under DVD/VCD multiple sound effect video playing mode, press to change channel(STEREO/LEFT CHANNEL/RIGHT CHANNEL).
- 21.SUBTITLE changing key
  Change the subtitle during playing if the Disc have multiple subtitle.

### PANEL PICTURE FUNCTION



#### 1. TURN ON/OFF & VOLUNE UP/DOWN

Long touch to turn ON/OFF the unit. Short touch to activate the MUTE function and silence the audio output. Touch again to rest ore sound. Rotate to adjust the output volume UP or DOWN

#### 2. HANG UP:

hang up the phone calls coming from Bluetooth. In other mode, press to go to next songs.

#### 3. TAKING CALLS:

taking the phone calls coming from Bluetooth. In other mode, press to choose previous songs.

#### 4. Angle adjusting:

3 steps up and 3 steps down adjusting.

#### 5. USB cover.

### 6. Eject key

When there is a Disc in the unit, touch EJECT to remove the Disc. And touch again to load the Disc if you do not take out it In the panel, there are many other keys and its function shows:

MODE:Touch to select system mode (BT/AUX IN/AV IN/Radio/MobileLinkx2/DVD/SD/USB)

**MENU:** Touch to access the MAIN Menu. Touch again to go back to last source menu.

**OPEN:** Make the screen stretching out or go back.

BAND: For radio band conversion between FM1/FM2/FM3/AM1/AM2


MIC: Receive hole

AUX: Front 3.5mm AUX in jack


**REL:** Press REL so that you can detach the front panel

## MAIN MENU OPERATION INSTRUCTION

Main menu 1



Main Menu 2



- 1. Shows the present time.
- 2.Page sliding button: slide or touch to choose the main menu 1 or main menu 2.

Touch the Radio, Disc, Bluetooth, MobileLink, USB, SD, AV in, AUX in, to select the corresponding source. Touch SWC to SWC setup menu, Touch Dimmer to adjust the brightness of the backlight ,Touch Setup to system setup menu.Scan the APK QC to download AKP to your android phone.

### SETUP MENU

There are five menu in setup:

#### **GENERAL SETUP—Menu 1**



- 1.Setup function area: General setup, Clock setup, Audio setup, Video setup, Other setup.
- 2. Subsidiary function area: Press to see the general setup items.
- a.Reverse: rear view camera ON/OFF function. Tuned OFF if you don't get a rear view camera.
- b.Reverse mirror: rear view image mirror.
- c.Beep: When turned on, an audible beep tone confirms each function selection.
- d.Radio Region: touch to choose the radio region.

#### **CLOCK SETUP - Menu 2**



- 1. This option is used when setting the clocks time manually
- 2.Touch to set the clock mode:12Hr/24Hr.Clock displays 12 hour time using AM and PM. Clock displays 24 hour time up to 23:59.
- 3. Shows the present time and mode you are setting.

#### **AUDIO SETUP--Menu 3**



- 1.FADER:Balances the audio output levels between the front and back side of the vehicle between 7R—7F.
- 2.BALANCE:Balances the audio output levels between the left and right side of the vehicle between 7L—7R.
- 3.BASS: Reduces or increases the bass frequency sound level between -7 to +7.
- 4.TREBLE: reduces or increases the high frequency sound levels between -7 to +7.
- 5.SUB: 0-7.
- 6.EQ: Choose the sound level and audio output effect between USER/JAZZ/POP/CLASSIC/ROCK. And USER is the default one.
- 7.Set ON to raise 6db for all.

#### VIDEO SETUP--Menu 4



- 1.Adjust DVD screen aspect ratio for viewing video:4:3 or 16:9.The disc must support 4:3 and 16:9 rate.
- 2.Adjust the backlight brightness of the screen:-5 to +5.
- 3. Adjust the video of the screen: -5 to +5.
- 4. Adjust the video of the screen: -5 to +5.


#### OTHER SETUP--Menu 5



- 1.Touch to start calibration function to make the touch feeling in the screen more accurate.
- 2. Restores the unit to factory settings.
- 3. Displays a screen which lists software version for the unit.

## **TOUCH CALIBRATION(Screen Calibration)**

If the touch screen controls are not working properly, perform a touch screen calibration. You can find in SETUP—OTHER SET UP menu. Click "OK" which is corresponding with CALIBRATION, a crosshair "+" appears in a corner quadrant of the screen.




◆To begin calibration, touch and hold the crosshair for one second, it will move to the next quadrant. Continue for each quadrant until the calibration is completed and the setup menu appears.


## MEDIA PLAYING—VIDEO FORM PLAYING

#### **RADIO OPERATION**



- 1. Shows the present mode. Press to turn back to the main menu.
- 2. Shows the present BAND and frequency source.
- 3. Short press to search backward.
- 4. Short press to search forward.
- 5. Radio preset stations area.
- 6.Band changing: Click to change between FM1/FM2/FM3/AM1/AM2.
- 7. Search the stations, play the searched one for 5S and go on to search next one.
- 8. Touch to seek backward/forward.
- 9.AS: Long touch to set as AS. Touch to save the stations with good reception automatically and scan each station for about 5 seconds.
- PS: Short touch to set as PS. Scan preset stations from 1 to 6.
- 10.RBDS: Touch to enter RBDS setup menu. You can choose the program type you like to listen: news, sport, Info,etc.
- 11.PTY: Program type; PS: Program service.

#### MEDIA PLAYING VIDEO FORM PLAYING



- 1. Touch to select one of the three Menu Control Bars: 1/3,2/3,3/3.
- 2. Touch to alter repeat mode in the following sequence:
- •DVD: Repeat Chapter, Repeat Title, Repeat OFF, Repeat All.
- •VCD (PBC OFF): Repeat Single, Repeat OFF, Repeat All.
- 3. Touch to move to previous chapter.
- 4.PLAY/PAUSE: Touch to begin playback. Touch the icon again to pause.
- 5. Touch to move to next chapter.
- 6.STOP: touch to stop playing.
- 7.Random play.
- 8. FAST REVERSE: Touch to fast play fast reverse at the speed of \*2\*4\*8\*16
- 9.FAST FORWARD: Touch to fast play fast forward at the speed of \*2\*4\*8\*16.
- 10. Touch to enter DVD Title.
- 11. Touch to enter DVD Menu.
- 12. Touch to zoom in or out during playback.
- 13. Touch to select the audio language.
- 14. Touch to select the subtitle language if the disc is recorded in multiple languages.

## MEDIA PLAYING—CD AUDIO PLAYIN

- 15. Touch to selcet DVD video angle.
- 16. Touch to repeat a specific portion from point A to point B of the DVD disc.
- 17. Touch to select chapter of DVD.

NOTE: When properly installed, DVD video cannot be displayed unless the parking brake is applied. If you attempt to play a DVD while the vehicle is moving, the screen displays the following warning.

## **USB/SD MUSIC PLAYING**

- 1.Track now playing \ Playing status \ The disc type.
- 2. Time bar shows total time and playing time of the present song.
- 3.Random play.
- 4.Repeat mode:Repeat the song or Repeat the disc.
- 5. Touch to view the song list of the CD.

#### Source Menu of CD

Touch the SOURCE MENU(ICON 5) to access to the CD track menu to view or change tracks manually. Touch again to return to the playback of the current track.



#### **USB/SD MUSIC PLAYING**

Press USB/SD in the main menu, music menu is all same with the Disc music. There is only one different: it will show more ID3 information on it such as: song name, singer.

- 1. Touch to select one of the two Menu Control Bars: 1/2,2/2.
- 2.Repeat mode adjusting.
- 3. Previous one.
- 4.PLAY/PAUSE: touch to begin play. Press again the icon to pause. During picture playing mode, one picture will be played for 5s automatically and goes to the next if you do not press it.
- 5.Next one.
- 6.STOP: touch to stop the picture playing and go back to the list mode.
- 7.Enter into setting menu for brightness, backlight and contract.
- 8.Zoom out/in the present picture.
- 9. Turn right 90 degrees.

## SWC-STEERING WHEEL CONTROL SETTING

#### SWC-STEERING WHEEL CONTROL SETTING

Set the VOL+ button as an example.

- 1.Press to enter into SWC menu Picture 1.
- 2.Press VOL+ button in the unit. You can see the reminder in the unit like Picture 2.
- 3.Press VOL+ in your steering wheel. The unit will show like picture 3. Means successful binding.

## MOBILE LINK X2 FUNCTION

#### **MOBILELINK X2 FUNCTION CAN ONLY BE AVAILABLE:**

- \* Connect your cell phone with the unit via BLUETOOTH.
- \* Install and run APK software(MOBILELINK X2) by smartphone.

#### **Bluetooth Connection Step**

Click BT icon in main menu to set Bluetooth ON; Open Bluetooth in your cellphone to search "Phone Pairing", click "Phone Pairing" and enter into the password "1234" to connect cellphone with the unit;

#### **MobileLink Software Installing**

**Method 1**:Scan APK QR code in the unit main menu2(or scan below QR code) to download and install MOBILELINK X2 software to your cellphone;

**Method 2**: Search MOBILELINK X2 in Google Play and install to your cellphone.

#### **MobileLink X2 function Operation**

- **1. RUN APK:** Click Mobilelink X2 in your Smartphone and you will see in smartphone: "Please connect your MobileLink cable".
- **2. LINK**: MobileLink port insert to unit MobileLink pigtail; USB port insert to unit USB pigtail; Mini port connect with cellphone.
- **3. OPERATION**: Click MobileLink X2 in main menu and both cellphone and unit will enter into 2way control menu as following:


